ABOUT MELKWEГ

The only surviving factory building within the Amsterdam canal ring, Melkweg is a former sugar factory, turned milk (melk) factory. This historical building houses three concert halls, a cinema, a multidisciplinary room, and an exhibition space. With a reach beyond our venue, Melkweg events can also be found at external locations across the city of Amsterdam.

PRODUCTION INSTRUCTIONS

Once your show at Melkweg has been confirmed you will be connected to a Production Manager (PM) to discuss all aspects of the advance including time schedule, crew details, etc. Important to know: The deadline for any changes regarding the time schedule, get-in time, and number of local crew is one week prior to the show date. Due to legalities regarding local crew labour restrictions, it's essential that the agreed-upon schedule is not exceeded on show day. If the INST set-up and sound check time require more than 3 hours then a surcharge of €250 per additional hour will be applied. These times do not apply to club night productions – discuss timings with PM.

ARTIST TAX & SETTLEMENT

All performers are subject to artist tax. Please read the following carefully: Performing artists can be exempt from artist tax if the artist proves they are a resident of a country in which the Netherlands has a tax treaty.

For performing artists who are from countries without a [tax treaty](#), the guarantee is subject to 20% tax. Dutch artists have to comply with regular Dutch income regulations. For these two groups (Dutch artists and artists from non-tax-treaty countries), €163 per artist is tax-free for expenses. By using the KVB Tax Exemption Regulations, artists can apply for more tax-free expenses.

*In order to make the correct payment, a passport copy of ALL performing artists must be provided before show day. **NO PASSPORT, NO PAYMENT!***

If you use direct licensing, please let us know in advance; otherwise, we won't be able to process it in the settlement.

ON ARRIVAL

Melkweg is situated in an old city where canals are common, and the streets are narrow and often congested. Proceed with caution!

Access to Melkweg parking on the Lijnbaansgracht may be blocked by a traffic pole. To have this lowered, ask our reception for assistance. Please note that there's another pole located on Raamplein. This pole blocks the road at specific moments, plan your trip to avoid these times:

- Thursday/Friday: 22:00 – 06:00
- Friday/Saturday: 22:00 – 06:00
- Saturday/Sunday: 22:00 – 06:00

PARKING

All vehicles must be confirmed in advance with the PM. Parking availability is extremely limited and reserved for touring buses, trucks and vans only; no private cars allowed. If necessary, details of nearby parking garages for cars can be provided.

Important - If your vehicle exceeds a weight of 7.5t (7,500kg), you must obtain a heavy traffic permit via the PM. This parking permit, available for large commercial (touring) vehicles, must be clearly visible at all times. Print the window card you receive from the PM and display this inside the vehicle's front windscreen.

A load in/out permit for non-heavy vehicles can be collected from the reception desk and displayed in the front windscreen. Please return this before leaving the Melkweg.

For an efficient load out, adhere strictly to the parking map provided by the PM. Position vehicles at the designated spot on our parking strip outside the venue. Please ensure you do not block any doorways or bridges as these are fire exits.

Melkweg can provide tour buses with a water connection and sufficient bus power (2x 3 phase 32A CEE-form). However, due to local noise restrictions in our residential zone, operating the bus's generator or parking overnight is not permitted. If overnight parking is required, please ask the PM for alternative parking facilities.

Please note parking at this venue is managed by the local government and is frequently checked. Non-compliance is enforced with fines. Follow the instructions above closely as Melkweg will not be liable for any potential parking fines.

LOAD IN/OUT

Street level access with a flat 50m push and a narrow turn. No loading dock and no ramp available; touring personnel must provide their own. Please inform us if you will be bringing prerigged trusses. Smallest doorway: 2.30m high and 1.50m wide.

LOCAL TECH CREW

Standard crew may include:

1x Stage Manager

1x FOH Engineer

1x Monitor Engineer

1x Light Engineer

1x Stagehand (load in & load out) – Additional cost applies for all-day stagehand; must be arranged in advance.

Extra stagehands available at an additional cost; arrange with PM in advance.

Please note: Final crew allocation will depend on your production's set-up and technical requirements. Standard crew for club nights may differ from the list above, so please coordinate with the PM to confirm the appropriate staffing.

RUNNER

Due to our central location, we generally do not recommend the use of runners. However, if one is required, arrangements must be made well in advance. The typical cost ranges between €750 and €1000 (incl rental). Alternatively, we can assist in coordinating ground transportation through trusted local providers.

DRESSING ROOMS

The Stage Manager will direct you to the following facilities that are available exclusively for this hall:

Melkweg is a smoke free venue – this includes all dressing rooms! Fines apply.

We will charge €350 per smoker, plus any additional fines applied by the city of Amsterdam.

WATER

In an attempt to reduce plastic waste we provide water bottles for stage use only; every dressing room has its own filtered water point for refills. Please inform the PM in advance of how much stage water is required.

MERCHANDISE

Fee €200.

Booth and boards are available in a well-lit, high-traffic area. The merchandise space is approximately 4.0 m wide (13 ft), with an additional 2.0 m (6.5ft) available upon request.

Fee does not include merch booth staff; if a seller is required please mention this to the PM in advance as we can connect you to a local merch company contact.

Please do NOT send merch to our venue without prior approval from the PM.

Unexpected deliveries will not be accepted by the venue!

The merch area may be used by club nights to facilitate various party features.

HEALTH & SAFETY

At Melkweg, the safety and well-being of our staff, artists, and guests are our top priority. We kindly request your cooperation in maintaining a healthy environment by using the necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), especially steel-capped shoes, while working in our halls.

As a standard, all Melkweg shows are with NO BARRIER.

For everyone's safety, we strictly prohibit stage diving and crowd surfing. Artists encouraging such activities will be held responsible for any ensuing incidents.

We prohibit the use of CO₂, sparklers and pyro in the Melkweg.

We uphold a zero-tolerance policy towards harassment at Melkweg. Our commitment is to foster a safe and inclusive environment for our staff, artists, and audience members. Any form of bullying, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

Please note that it is not possible to turn off our ventilation system (air-conditioning), as it is an integral part of our building's air quality management and fire safety compliance. The system ensures continuous air circulation, supports temperature regulation, and is essential for maintaining safe CO₂ levels and emergency smoke extraction.

We take appropriate measures against COVID-19, complying with the latest local rules and regulations, and maintaining our ventilation systems in optimal condition.

We are a smoke free venue – Fines apply.

PRIVACY & FILMING

If filming is planned within the venue, please ensure that local crew members are not captured on camera while working. Should you wish to film during the show, prior notice is required, as we may need to display signage to inform the public. Additionally, the use of drones is strictly prohibited both inside and outside the venue. We reserve the right to restrict or halt filming at any time if it interferes with operations, compromises safety, or violates privacy standards.
